



## Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. Where are we going?

### 2. When are we going?

July 17-24, 2010, a Saturday to Saturday. We will leave from church at 2pm on the 17th and return on early Saturday afternoon. Parents, be prepared for a cell phone call when we're an hour away.

### 3. Why are we going?

To serve a small church plant in Indianapolis by assisting them in their Vacation Bible School and their Young Adult Late Night Outreach. To provide extra hands in accomplishing some work projects for those in need in their community. To become a little more like Jesus by being servant leaders in all we do.

### 4. Who is going?

Mike & Robyn Miller will be the adults. The rest of the work team will be made up of SR HI students.

### 5. How are we getting there?

We will be taking the church van and trailer.

### 6. Where will we be sleeping?

The people of Woodside Community Church has graciously opened their homes to host our kids. Guys will be staying at one house and girls will be staying at another. Robyn and Mike will be sleeping in a hard side camper that a family from Woodside offered to let them use.

### 7. What about food?

Each student will be responsible for one meal on the road going down and one meal on the way back as well as their meals on Friday when we have a little end-of-the-week fun. Breakfasts during the week will be covered by the family that is hosting the students. Lunch & dinner is being covered by the church through a combination of restaurants which have donated free meals and families that cooked meals for our team.

### 10. So what will we be doing all week? What's the schedule?

Our primary focus will be helping the church out with their vacation bible school (VBS). In support of that, we will be meeting with their leaders on Sunday morning, July 18, to be briefed on how things will be working. Our students will primarily be small group leaders, or crew leaders as they call them. We will be passing out flyers in the neighborhood around the church on Sunday afternoon with the VBS starting that night at 6pm and going until 8:15pm. We will meet each day afterwards to debrief and troubleshoot. The VBS runs each night from 6pm-8:15, Sunday through Thursday. At 8:30pm, on Monday to Thursday, there will be a "Young Adult Late Night" outreach to teens that will be activity based (Movie night, Water Wars with a mud pit, scavenger hunt, and a closing praise & worship time at Mark's house) Friday will be our fun day and I'm trying to keep this a surprise, but parents, if you want to know, call Mike's cell phone. We will return on Saturday July 24 in the early afternoon.

## Stuff You Need To Bring
