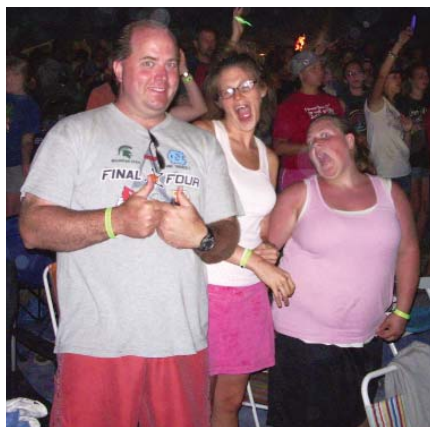
COLLEGE AGE STUFF
