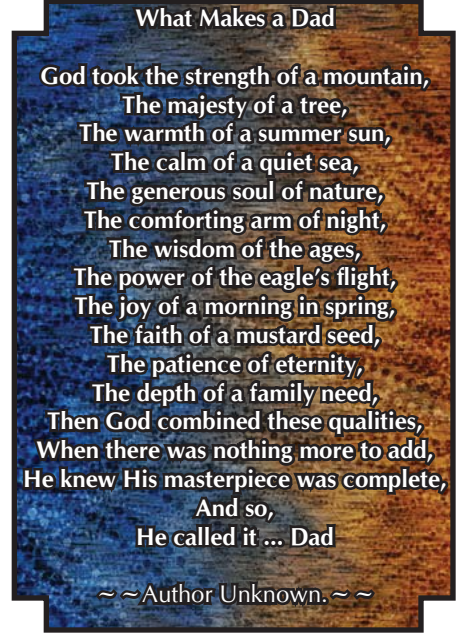

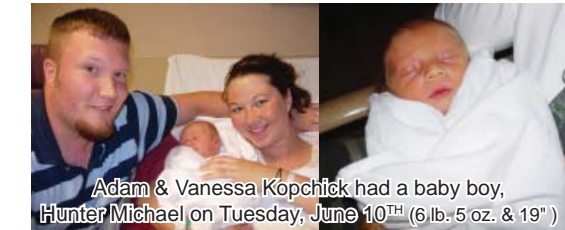




**Dan Stevens' 25 Years as Choir Director**
