COLLEGE AGE CAMPING TRIP

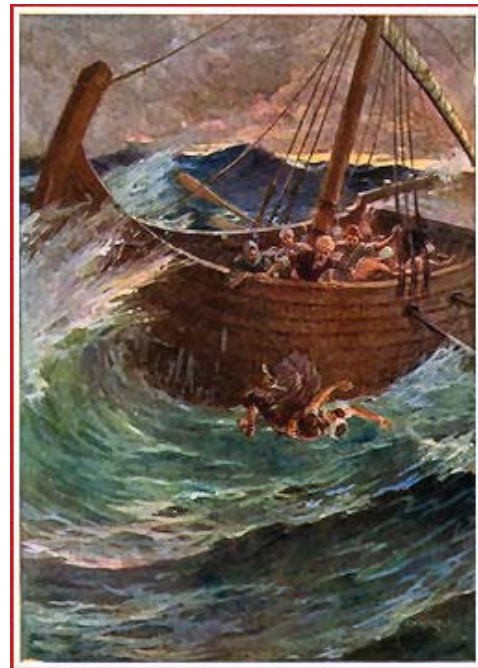
