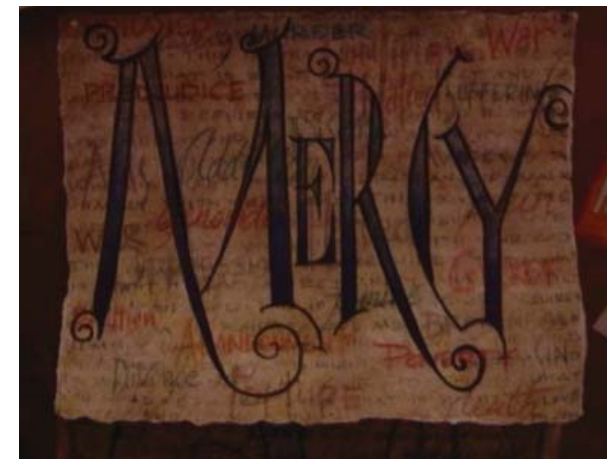
COLLEGE AGE NEWS ... HE'S BACK
