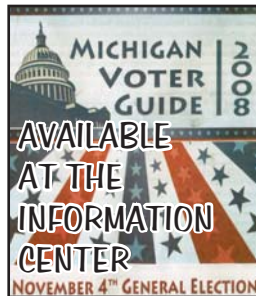
**We Are Called To Be God's People**
