QUIZ PRACTICE, TOURNAMENT

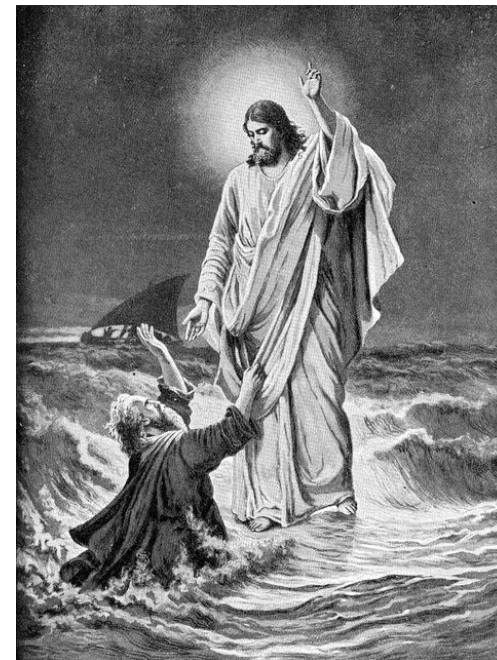
JV/LL Teams-Sun, Nov 16-1:45pm-3:15pm-church
