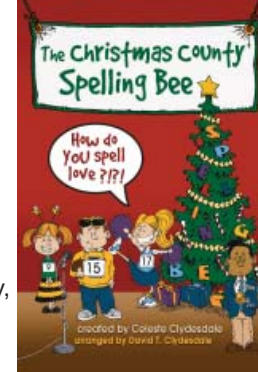

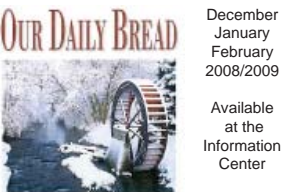

QUIZ PRACTICE, TOURNAMENT RESULTS

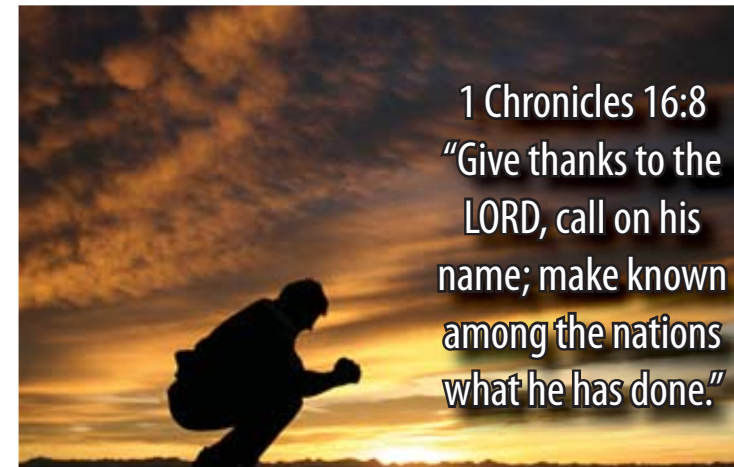
JV/LL Teams-Sun, Nov 23-1:45pm-3:15pm-church
