COLLEGE & CAREER, KAHVA

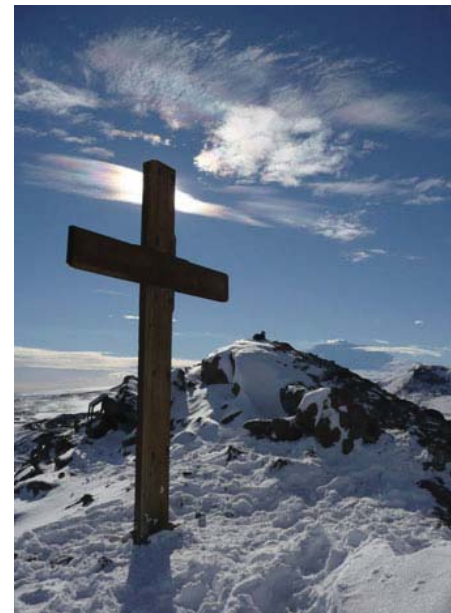
COLL-Sun, Feb 8-9:30am-Sanctuary (Missions)
