**COLLEGE & CAREER, KAHVA FRIDAY**

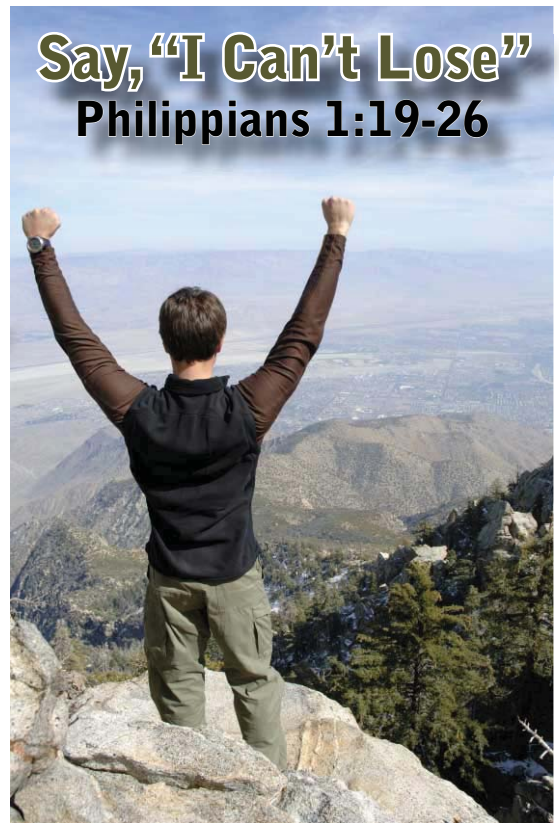
