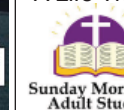

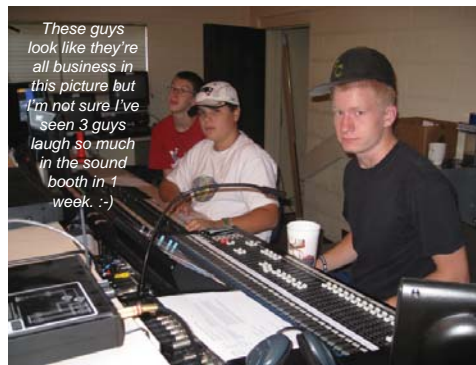
## C&C, GREAT ADV. TOP 10, FIRE & REIGN
