BIBLE QUIZZING TEAMS FORMING

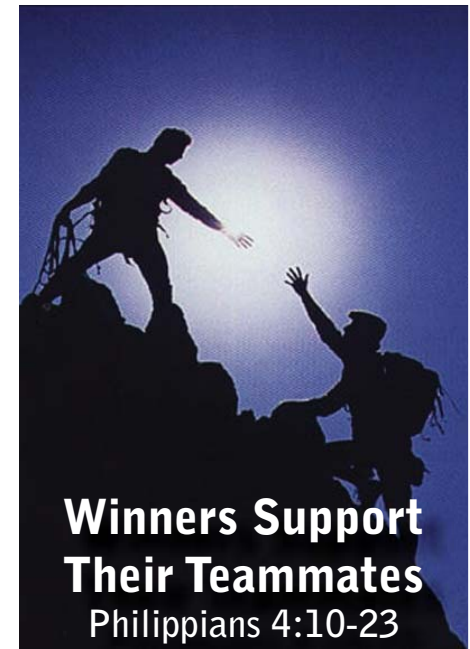
ALL-Sept-March-weekly practices, monthly competitions
