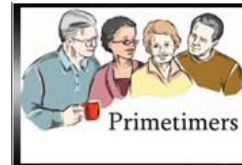
Announcements & Opportunities

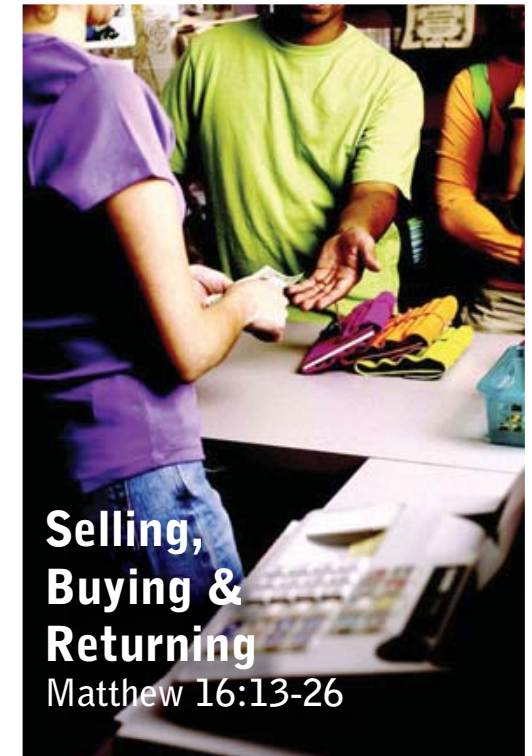
COLLEGE & CAREER FIRE & REIGN
