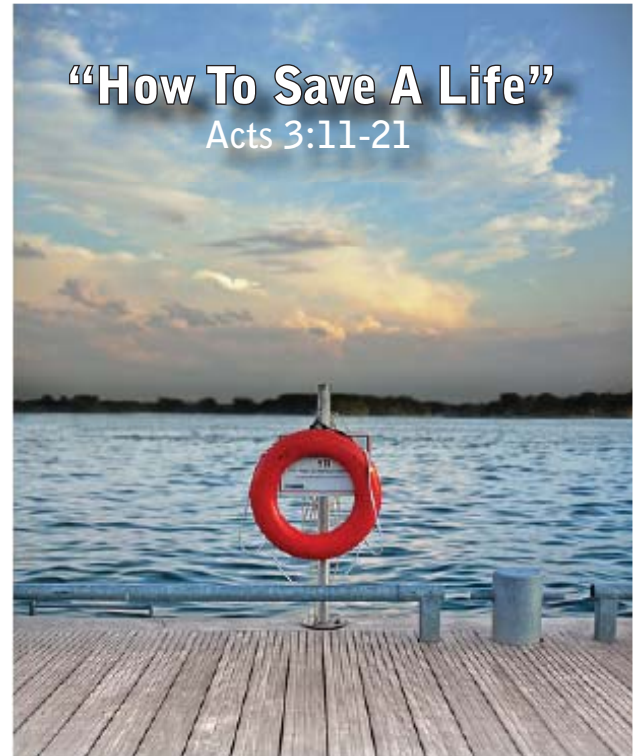
COLL-Sun, Oct 11-9:30am-Kahva Room
